

**Big Sky Relief Fund; Request for Proposals**  
**January 8, 2020**

The Big Sky Relief Fund came together under the 501 (c) (3) umbrella of the Yellowstone Club Community Foundation as a collaborative of local funders to provide economic relief and support to community members experiencing hardship due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. The partners include Yellowstone Club Community Foundation, Spanish Peaks Community Foundation, Moonlight Community Foundation and the Big Sky Area Resort Tax District. Due to the tenure of the pandemic and the dynamic ways it is impacting our community, the Big Sky Relief Fund is requesting proposals from local not-for-profit or public entities to fund programming and support in the following areas related to the COVID-19 pandemic:

- 1) Programming that supports employees to return to work during the pandemic. This includes, but is not limited to, programming for children so parents and guardians can return to work i.e. childcare and out of school/virtual school support.
- 2) Physical and Behavioral health programming/services to support the well-being of our community throughout the duration of the pandemic.
- 3) Support services or resources for families and employees who are experiencing economic hardship due to the pandemic.

Requirements to qualify for the grant:

- 1) Must be a 501 c (3) or public entity
- 2) Must provide direct services in the Big Sky community
